Work Experience at Paradise Wildlife Park

There will be induction training prior to you commencing your work experience for one hour; if you miss this induction then you may forfeit your work experience placement.

Work Experience hours are from 8am until 4pm, Monday through to Friday. Each day includes free time for 2 breaks and Lunch; you may bring a packed lunch to work each day or purchase food from the cafeteria at staff rates as long as you are wearing your name badge which will be issued during the induction meeting.

Students report directly to Jan Hooper our work experience/volunteer co-ordinator.

Each student is expected to participate fully in all aspects of animal care including; preparing & dispensing feeds and maintaining their healthy environments. We are unable to allocate work experience students to one section in the Park exclusively and they are expected to assist wherever they are needed most. Students are not permitted to work with the Carnivores.

Students are required to dress appropriately for outdoor work: clothes should be comfortable, weatherproof and warm. Heavy duty boots are beneficial although you may be comfortable with trainers or similar.

There is no public transport close to the park and the nearest shops are about 3 miles away. Broxbourne Train Station is also approx 3 miles. White Stubbs Lane is a country lane and is unlit

Our minibus is available to pick up from Broxbourne station at 7:50am and 8:30am.

Work experience students under the age of 18 are not permitted to smoke on site.
