

# Farm Animals

Ideas under the topic can include:

## KEY STAGE 1:

- List/draw as many different farm animals as they can.
- List the animal products produced from each animal.
- Use the farm experience to make a list of words associated with each farm animal. Use as a basis for poem/story.
- Produce pictures/paintings of farm animals using contrasting materials for the animals coat, fur or feathers.

## KEY STAGE 2:

- Discuss and chart the different kinds of products produced by farm animals.
- Look at the way in which farming has shaped the local landscape and the changes it has endured over the years.
- Discuss the concept of free range Hens versus battery Hens. Produce a story, poem or song that contrasts the two different living conditions. How do you feel the hens at Paradise Wildlife Park feel about their living conditions?
- Write a short dialogue between different farm animals that highlights how humans treat them.

**To support the topic of "Farm Animals", Paradise Wildlife Park has to offer:**

1. A friendly selection of farm animals and pets (rabbits and guinea pigs).
2. Farm animals that are housed in a very interactive setting so they can be fed and touched by the children.
3. Adequate sinks and water supply for the children to wash their hands after touching the animals.
